



## Resolution No. 3

GA-2017-86-RES-03

**Subject:** Revision of the Staff Regulations

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Beijing, China, from 26 to 29 September 2017, at its 86th session:

HAVING REGARD TO Articles 8, 22 and 29 of the Constitution, Article 53 of the General Regulations and Article 14.3(1) and (2) of the Staff Regulations,

BEARING IN MIND Resolution AG-2016-RES-02, adopted by the General Assembly at its 85th session, approving the recommendations of the General Secretariat, in particular Recommendation 14 to undertake a complete revision of the Staff Regulations and Rules,

HAVING EXAMINED Report GA-2017-86-REP-03 submitted by the General Secretariat concerning the revision of the Staff Regulations, and the draft revised Staff Regulations contained therein,

ACKNOWLEDGING that consultation has taken place between the General Secretariat and the Staff Committees, in conformity with Staff Rule 9.2.8(1), and TAKING NOTE of the Staff Committees' opinions on the proposed changes,

ALSO HAVING EXAMINED the opinion of the ad hoc committee set up in application of Article 56 of the Organization's General Regulations,

RECALLING that, under the terms of Article 8(d) of INTERPOL's Constitution, the General Assembly is empowered to determine any other regulations deemed necessary,

RECALLING that, under the terms of Article 22(e) of INTERPOL's Constitution, the Executive Committee shall exercise all the powers delegated to it by the General Assembly,

ENDORSES the conclusions contained in the above report concerning the revision of the Staff Regulations;

APPROVES the amended Staff Regulations as set out in Appendix 1 to Report GA-2017-86-REP-03;

INSTRUCTS the Executive Committee:

- To adopt revised Staff Rules, in line with the Staff Regulations thus amended, based on the proposals that will be submitted to it in 2018 by the Secretary General;
- To determine the date on which the revised Staff Regulations and Staff Rules will simultaneously enter into force;

- To adopt transitional measures necessary for the entry into force of the said texts, without any prejudice to the acquired rights of staff in service at that date;
- To adopt specific procedures for the secondment or loan of staff members by member countries;

ASKS the Secretary General to exercise the powers granted to him under Article 29 of the Constitution with due respect for the provisions of the revised Staff Regulations and Rules.
