Subject: Membership of the Solomon Islands

The ICPO-INTERPOL General Assembly, meeting in Beijing, China, from 26 to 29 September 2017 at its 86th session:

BEARING IN MIND Article 4 of the Constitution,

TAKING NOTE of the application for membership dated 5 August 2015 submitted by the Minister of Police, National Security and Correctional Service of the Solomon Islands, and endorsed by the Prime Minister of the Solomon Islands on 20 July 2017,

CONSIDERING the elements contained in the application with regard to the requirements of membership,

CONSIDERING that in a letter dated 6 July 2017, the Solomon Islands indicated that the obligations under Articles 2 to 7 and 31 to 33 of the INTERPOL Constitution are understood,

CONSIDERING that upon membership and in compliance with Article 32 of the Constitution, the Solomon Islands shall appoint a body which will serve as the National Central Bureau,

DECIDES:

- The Solomon Islands shall be a Member of the Organization with effect from the present session of the General Assembly;
- The Solomon Islands shall be part of Asia for the purposes of participation in the regional conferences and membership of the Executive Committee;
- The contribution of the Solomon Islands for the year 2018 shall amount to 0.03% of the Organization's budget;

TASKS the Secretary General to implement, in compliance with the existing rules, rights of access to the INTERPOL Information System of the National Central Bureau to be designated by the Solomon Islands.
